Project Description: The proposal is to construct a 101' x 193'swine finishing building with a 10'deep pit for manure storage. The APE is approximately 3 acres. The project is to be constructed in the Nonresponsive Mason County, IL. The pit is designed for a minimum 12 month storage capacity. The manure will be injected directly into the soil of the adjacent farmland by a commercial applicator at approved agronomic rates.

In considering FSA's responsibilities pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water Act and its implementing regulations, we are requesting your assistance in identifying potential adverse impacts to a sole source aquifer which may be affected by this project.

FSA has reviewed the list of sole source aquifers, and to the best of our knowledge there is no indication of probable adverse impacts. Attached for your reference are:
